

The Choice Program at UMBC is a mentoring and advocacy program operated out of the Shriver Center. The program is 100% grant funded and staff and mentors purchase food and supplies for youth, families and program activities. Staff and mentors are eligible to be reimbursed for these purchases and submit requests to their supervisors for approval. The reimbursement requests are also reviewed by the Shriver Center's Business Services team. The Choice Program has operated as a part of UMBC since 1988.
